WHEREAS, an Agreement with AFSCME Local 1158 has been reached on behalf of said Bargaining Unit and the City of Marion and ratified by the Bargaining Unit to be effective April 1, 2019.

Section 1. That Council hereby ratifies and approves the bargaining agreement between the City of Marion and AFSCME Local 1158.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and its' inhabitants thereof and for the further reason that the current contract expired on March 31, 2022; and as such shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its' passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

The City Administration Bargaining Team has come to a tentative agreement with the American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees Local 1158 membership which represents Marion City employees at the City Garage, Waste Water Treatment and Marion Area Transit.
