ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE LEASE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2016 DEMO MODEL HME CUSTOM PUMPER FROM 911 FLEET AND FIRE EQUIPMENT, PURSUANT TO ORC 735.051, APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Marion has received a quote to purchase one demo model 2016 HME Custom Pumper at a reduced cost due to the model being a demo, and

WHEREAS, in order to fully utilize the cost saving of the demo model purchase, as such may not be available at a later date due to the fact that the truck is for sale to any entity, and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Ohio: Marion County,

Section 1. The Safety Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with 911 Fleet & Fire Equipment and 911 Fleet & Fire Finance for the purchase of one demo model 2016 HME Custom Pumper for the total cost of \$379,381.00.

Section 2. Based upon the report of the Safety Director and the limited availability of the demo model, the Council determines it is necessary as an emergency under ORC 735.051 to capture the cost savings and the urgent need to purchase the demo equipment while it is still available. Therefore, the Council declares an emergency exists and authorizes the Safety Director to complete the purchase of said demo.

Section 3. That the annual lease purchase for the demo model shall be for the term of ten (10) years paid from the Capital Improvement Fund 401.4000.5444.

Section 3. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds for the initial down payment as follows:

Capital Equipment	401.4000.5444	\$37,939.00
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Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and its inhabitants thereof: Due to the real and present need to move forward without delay given the significant cost savings and potential unavailability of the demo model; and as such shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
