

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO
CONTRACT WITH STEVENS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY,
INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MARION
AIRPORT TERMINAL, APPROPRIATING NECESSARY
FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has authorized grant funding of up to \$600,000.00 for the eligible cost of construction of a new Airport Terminal.

WHEREAS, Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has authorized funding of 5% of the total eligible cost of construction.

WHEREAS, The bid opening was held on June 27, 2019 and 3 companies responded. Stevens Construction submitted the lowest and best bid of \$1,180,646.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County,

Section 1: That the Director of Public Service be directed to enter into contract with Stevens Construction Company, Inc. for a total amount not to exceed more than \$1,200,000.00, for the construction of a new Airport Terminal building.

Section 2: That the cost of such contract shall be payable from FAA grant, ODOT grant, the Airport Improvement Fund, Airport Industrial Park Fund, and General Funds, and the Auditor is authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; as application for the disbursement of FAA and ODOT grant funds must be made before August, 2019, and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
