## Item 1. ZONING MAP CHANGE 111 SUPERIOR STREET/717 DELAWARE AVENUE FROM R-1C TO C-1B TO MATCH THE EAST HALF (Applicant – Amy and Lakhwinder Singh)

Robert Morris, Marion Regional Planning, reviewed the staff report and submitted it for the record. The parcel is a convenience store and gas station. It is one lot that has each half zoned differently. The request is to rezone the west half of the parcel from R-1C to C-1B to match the east half. This application is a result of an application for a variance to the Board of Zoning Appeals to allow for a drive thru on the west side of the building. The area that will be used for drive through lanes would be considered to support a commercial use and, in order to comply with the zoning code, it would need to be rezoned to C-1B.

Regional Planning Commission staff recommend approving the rezone from R-1C to C-1B.

There is an existing curb cut at each entrance. They believe that ingress and egress is large enough. Signage will be installed to direct traffic.

Mr. Berry made a motion to recommend Zoning Map change to council, Mr. Zucker 2<sup>nd</sup>. All Ayes.
