NEW BUSINESS:

Item 1. ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FISHER EXCAVATING FOR THE DEMOLITION OF 483-487 W. CENTER ST. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Evelyn Warr-Cummings, Regional Planning, explained that the owner is willing to consent to demolition. They are exploring options for a neighborhood group to do beautification. This project along with next one will exhaust demolition money. She has bid out some other projects that she may fall back on if money remains after the higher priority items are completed, including one that involves some clean up of rubble on N. Vine Street.

Item 3. DISCUSSION ONLY: CDBG Project Selection Schedule

Evelyn Warr-Cummings, Regional Planning, called attention to the CDBG application sand schedule for projects. March 11, 2019 is the public hearing. She has heard that there may be some changes to the downtown grant that may make it easier and they may want to pursue that. Ideas are due by 04/05/2019. They will come back to committee for presentations. Mid to late April, they will establish a tentative budget. Then they will set up a second public hearing by 05/13/2019. There will be about \$120,000 for up to three projects (after administrative costs taken out).

Mr. Ratliff pointed out that at one time they thought these grants may go away. He was glad that they have not. Ms. Warr-Cummings said that the 2019 funds are unknown at this time. Money for these grants has gone up about 10% under current administration.
