

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH JONES AND HENRY ENGINEERS, LTD. FOR THE ENGINEERING AND DESIGN OF THE BOONE AVENUE SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT 21-2S FOR THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO, APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2020-36 authorized the Service Director to conduct an RFP process for the Boone Avenue Sewer Improvement Project 21-2S for the City of Marion, Ohio and

WHEREAS, A Request for Proposal process was conducted with proposals due on January 22, 2021 and 5 firms responded. After a review of all proposals, Jones And Henry Engineers, Ltd. was selected and a design fee of \$50,000.00 was negotiated.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Works be directed to enter into contract with Jones And Henry Engineers, Ltd. for the total amount of \$50,000.00 for the Boone Avenue Sewer Improvement Project 21-2S.

Section 2: That the cost of such contract shall be payable from the Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Improvement Funds, and Auditor is authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and since Boone Avenue is in dire need of repair; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
