

ORDINANCE MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN THE BELOW LISTED FUNDS TO COVER UNANTICIPATED EXPENSES ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) gives workers and their families who lose their health benefits the right to choose to continue group health benefits provided by their group health plan

WHEREAS, COBRA requires that group health plans sponsored by employers with 20 or more employees in the prior year offer employees and their families the opportunity for a temporary extension of health coverage

WHEREAS, Employees qualify for COBRA if they have voluntary or involuntary job loss, reduction in the hours worked, transition between jobs, death, divorce and other life events.

WHEREAS, Under the city plan, employees are eligible for COBRA for 18 months and must pay the entire premium for coverage by the 15th of the month prior to the month of coverage.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County Ohio Section 1. The Auditor is hereby authorized to make the following appropriation COBRA
