

ORDINANCE MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN THE BELOW LISTED POLICE FUNDS TO COVER ADDITIONAL COBRA EXPENSES DUE TO RETIREMENT ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) gives workers and their families who lose their health benefits the right to choose to continue group health benefits provided by their group health plan

WHEREAS, Employees qualify for COBRA if they have voluntary or involuntary job loss, reduction in the hours worked, transition between jobs, death, divorce and other life events.

WHEREAS, An employee has retired from the Marion City Police Department and has chosen to keep their health insurance through the COBRA plan

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County Ohio Section 1. The Auditor is hereby authorized to make the following appropriation for the pass through of funds.
