

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A (MAULDIN MP-650) PAVER FOR THE STREETS DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has the understanding that the Streets Department is in dire need of a new Asphalt Paver; and

WHEREAS, under ORC 9.48 (Joint purchasing programs), a political subdivision can participate in a joint purchasing program operated by or through a national or state association of political subdivision in which the purchasing political subdivision is eligible for membership; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Ohio: Marion County,

Section 1. That the PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR is hereby authorized and is hereby directed to enter into contract with SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT (Government pricing) for the purchase of a new Asphalt Paver for use in the Streets Department. The Total cost including trade in and net cost of \$78,650. Council authorizes the disposal of the used paver by trading same in as a credit towards the cost of the new unit. The cost is funded from the SCMR Fund 202.2006.5442.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor given the real and present need to obtain as quickly as possible for necessary repairs, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
