WHEREAS, after soliciting from a pool of qualified demolition contractors price quotes were received from three contractor, and

WHEREAS, Fisher Excavating bid was lowest and best for the base bid of \$15,120, and

WHEREAS, the FY 2017 CDBG Formula Allocation grant has \$60,500 budgeted for the demolition of blighted structures, and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety be directed to enter into contract Fisher Excavating for the demolition of 483-487 W. Center St.

Section 2. That \$15,120 of the demolition contract shall be payable from the City of Marion's CDBG FY 2017 Formula Allocation grant

Section 3. That it is desirable to demolition the structure as soon as practical to avoid potential injury and nuisance caused by vacant and abandoned structures.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof: and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 2. That \$7,974 of the demolition contract shall be payable from the City of Marion's CDBG FY 2017 Formula Allocation grant.

Section 3. That it is desirable to demolition the structure as soon as practical to avoid potential injury and nuisance caused by vacant and abandoned structures.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof: and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council: otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
