ORDINANCE MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN THE CAPITAL CONTINGENCY FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO WORKING CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM, FOR ELIGIBLE BUSINESSES FOR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY **AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, the City of Marion has received funding under the CARES Act, and

WHEREAS, the City of Marion wishes to make *up to* \$100,000.00 available to eligible business to help with expenses caused by the COVID pandemic based on the related ordinance passed for that purpose, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Marion will appropriate the following funds for that purpose_*and those funds will be reimbursement from CARES Act Fund 275*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County Ohio

Section 1. That the following appropriation, be made as follows

Capital Improvement

Capital contingency 401.4000.5444 **UP TO** \$100,000.00

Section 2.— The Council in order to fund said Working Capital Grant Program does hereby deappropriates the sum of, up to, \$ 100,000.00 from Ordinance 2020-76, more particularly from Section ______ item ______. Any monies not distributed under the Working Capital Grant Program pursuant to this appropriation Ordinance shall be enabled to be expended for qualifiable expenses under Cares Act 3 by the Administration under Ordinance 2020-76.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
