ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KOKOSING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2020 STREET RESURFACING, PROJECT 20-1R FOR THE CITY OF MARION, OHIO, APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2020-23 authorized the preparation of specifications and advertising for bids for the 2020 Street Resurfacing Project 20-1R for the City of Marion, Ohio and

WHEREAS, Bid openings were held on May 28, 2020 and 2 companies responded. Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. submitted the lowest and best bid of \$1,177,220.82.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Public Works Director is authorized to enter into contract with Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. for the total amount of \$1,177,220.82, for 2020 Street Resurfacing Project 20-1R.

Section 2: That the cost of such contract shall be payable from SCM&R Fund and the Auditor is authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the welfare of the City of Marion and the inhabitants thereof; and since the streets included with this project are in dire need of repair; and as such, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council; otherwise it shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH PARK ENTERPRISE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CIRCULAR DRIVE AT THE MARION MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, The City of Marion is eligible for up to \$150,00.00 FAA Grant and would become known as Project 27 at the Marion Municipal Airport.

WHEREAS, Bid opening for this project was held on May 29, 2020 with four (4) valid bids received by the City of Marion. After review of all bids, Park Enterprise Construction Co. Inc. was determined to be the best bid received for this project.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Safety/Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Park Enterprise Construction Company, Inc. for the construction of the terminal circular drive at the Marion Municipal Airport.

Section 2. The cost of such contract shall be 100% payable from FAA grant funds.

Section 3. The Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate the necessary funds in the Airport Improvement Fund (408).

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
