

ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF CASS AVENUE TO MARTIN LUTHER KING STREET

WHEREAS, the petition of John Harris was duly presented to Council praying that the name of Cass Avenue, as presently located within the City of Marion, be changed to Martin Luther King Street, to foster pride and point out the significance of the name of Martin Luther King Park, and

WHEREAS, said petition was approved by the Marion City Planning Commission at its December 4, 2018 meeting, after having been referred to it by City Council, and

WHEREAS, Council, reviewing ORC 723.04 and upon review of the comments including those offered at public hearing, is now satisfied that there is good cause for such change of name and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and should to be made.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marion, Marion County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the name of Cass Avenue is hereby changed to Martin Luther King Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
