This matter came to be heard on the written application of the Marion City Law Director, who requested the appointment of a special prosecutor to present the State's case in the above entitled cause, investigate and conduct all necessary activities related to the duties of a prosecutor as to certain campaign procedures and campaign practices related to the November 2019 general election during the months of October and November 2019.

For good cause shown the Court finds it is necessary and will serve to avoid the appearance of conflict of interest as the parties conduct the work of each Office on behalf of the citizens of the City of Marion, Ohio. Appointment of a special prosecutor will ensure the appearance of fairness and impartiality required of all parties. Further, it is in the public interest to appoint a special prosecutor for the purposes of presenting the State's case in the above entitled cause, investigating and conducting all necessary activities related to the duties of a prosecutor as to certain campaign procedures and campaign practices related to the November 2019 general election during the months of October and November 2019.

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Honorable Terry Hord is hereby APPOINTED by this Court through its inherent powers (See State, ex rel. Thomas v. Henderson,) (1931), 123 Ohio St. 474 to be a Special Prosecuting Attorney for the Office of the Marion City Law Director. The Special Prosecuting Attorney shall have all powers and responsibilities needed to investigate, present State's case, prosecute through the completion of trial, any criminal charges arising from misconduct committed by candidates, campaign workers, or party office holders for the period of October and November 2019. The Special

Prosecuting Attorney shall be compensated at the rate of \$ 100.00 per hour. Total compensation shall not exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) in this case. However, no mileage or travel expenses shall be reimbursed. The Special Prosecuting Attorney shall have access to the secretarial resources of the Marion City Law Director's Office, as he deems appropriate. This appointment shall continue until the Special Prosecuting Attorney issues a report to this Court indicating that the investigation is complete and all criminal charges have been prosecuted through the end of any trial(s) that may occur. In no event shall this appointment continue, without an extension from this Court, beyond August 1, 2020. The Special Prosecuting Attorney shall submit to this Court, in writing, his statement of billing for professional services rendered at least once every two (2) months. The first statement of billing shall be submitted no later than sixty (60) days after the filing of this Entry.
