MEET RANDY MOORE

Randy Moore has enjoyed his time as maintenance supervisor at the Marion Senior Center, but there are just some things he wants to do before it's too late.

"Working four plus hours a day doesn't give you time to do much else," he said on June 27th, his 67th birthday. "And there are things I want to do before I'm too old."

Randy has worked at the Marion Senior Center for a little over eight years now. He has worked 8 a.m. to noon, and sometimes beyond that, working to maintain the cleanliness of the facility, making repairs, maintaining some of the landscaping and just generally keeping an eye on things. "Cleanliness is number one to me, everyone likes a pleasant environment," He said. "I also shovel snow, but I won't miss that!"

Randy has also put his woodworking skills to use during the last eight years, making a "cash machine" for the center as well as card holders to make it easier for members to hold a large number of cards, and he has also made and donated cutting boards to different events.

Randy found his way to the center just about a month after he retired from Honda. "I retired March 30 and got this one April 30," he said, adding that he heard about the opening at the senior center as he was getting ready to leave Honda and he decided to apply.

Originally from south of Richwood, Randy grew up on his parent's farm there and learned all the knowledge and skills that have made him so successful while working on the farm. "It helped a lot in my life and career," he said.

His career has spanned a stint in the U.S. Navy, 13 years at BF Goodrich and 23 years at Honda. During that time, he also met and married his wife of 44 years, Janie. They have one daughter.



Now that he's retiring, Randy has a lot of plans to keep himself every bit as busy as he's been at the senior center, however.

"I've got a lot to do," he said, adding woodworking projects to the list, as well as golf, travel, and helping out his daughter's family with little repairs to the list. "We have two grandsons who keep us busy. One was six at the end of June and the other is 16 months."

"It's been enjoyable, I've met a lot of good people," he said of his time at the center, adding that he won't be a stranger. "I will come back in for evening activities, to help set up and tear down. And I'll be back to help with special events, or if they need help with the garden or need something made."
